## REQUIREMENTS AND PROCEEDURES

## First-time Applicants

- 1. The applicant must have a high school diploma, a General Education Diploma (GED), or be enrolled in their senior year of high school and be eligible for graduation this application year. A copy of such must be attached to this application.
- 2. The applicant must be accepted or enrolled in an accredited higher education institution leading to a degree or certificate in their field of study. A copy of the acceptance letter must be attached to this application.
- 3. The applicant must be classified as a full time student (12 or more semester hours in an accredited higher education institution such as a college, university, junior college, vocation or trade school.
- 4. If the applicant is a High School Senior, they **must attach to this application, a letter of recommendation from their high school counselor** stating that they are qualified for higher education and will graduate from high school in this academic year.
- 5. If the applicant has already graduated from high school at the time of this application, a copy of a letter of acceptance from the school they are planning to attend must be **attached to this application**; instead of the letter from the high school counselor; A copy of the course schedule must be submitted to the Sr, Vice when available.
- 6. If the applicant is enrolled in a school of higher learning, a copy of the transcript and grades from the previous semester must accompany this application. An academic grade point average of 2.0 or higher on a 4.0 scale must be maintained and submitted with this application for consideration of a scholarship.
- 7. A grade point average of 2.0 or higher on a 4.0 scale must be obtained during high school and a copy of the grade report for the most current semester of high school **must be submitted with this application** if the applicant has not completed a full semester of higher education.
- 8. A 3 inch by 5 inch current head and shoulder photograph must accompany this application.

The committee will endeavor to award the scholarship by August 15<sup>th</sup> for the fall semester, and January 1<sup>st</sup> for the spring semester of each year.

## **Renewal Applications**

Renewal applicants need to submit a renewal application, provide a copy of their current grades from the college, university, or trade school, and submit a schedule of the upcoming semester showing 12 or more semester hours.. The sponsor must continue to be a qualified sponsor and submit information as requested by the scholarship committee.
